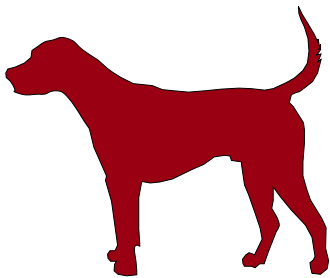

Upon adoption all canines are current on age appropriate core vaccinations, deworming, nail trim and monthly preventative. Vaccinations should be completed every four weeks until 16 weeks of age. The DA2PP, rabies and heartworm test should be completed one year from the rabies vaccination. Continue with monthly heartworm prevention to protect your dog from common heartworm disease and costly treatment. Spay and neuter should be completed at six months of age. If adopters choose to perform spay/neuter through Foster2Forever, it will be done at a discounted rate, and all age-appropriate vaccinations will be provided during the surgery.
